A NEW YEAR AND A NEW CLASS!

2025 marks the first quarter of this century. Some of us remember how we rang in the new century on December 31, 1999. Or maybe you recall the anticipated fear of our technology devices imploding at the stroke of midnight on January 1, 2000.

25 years later, DAPS is welcoming a new year with a new class to the PD community, our first Noncontact Boxing class! When DAPS Medical Advisory Board member, Dr. Mike Braitsch, announced the closure of his physical therapy clinic in the summer of 2024, a new opportunity presented itself. DAPS and Dr. Mike began working together closely to create, design and implement a Noncontact Boxing certification workshop to train DAPS instructors on how to lead these specific classes.

Dr. Mike is highly regarded for his research-backed services he has provided to the Parkinson's disease community for almost a decade. One of these services, Noncontact Boxing for people with PD, became a popular and highly sought-after service. Dr. Mike's clinical and research studies on the benefits of Noncontact Boxing for people with



PD are internationally recognized by those in the movement disorder field. Improvements in balance, stamina and coordination are just a few of the benefits to participating in Noncontact Boxing.

Thanks to a generous donation, DAPS was able to cover all costs of the training workshop, with no cost to instructors. Six DAPS instructors completed the 6-hour in-person workshop in December, taught by Dr. Mike. With help from nine of his former patients, instructors gained more hands-on experience to learn and better understand Noncontact Boxing for PD.











DAPS instructors will receive their certification to begin teaching Noncontact Boxing after completing their final assignment in January. Look for an email with a short survey about your interest and availability in participating in the new Noncontact Boxing class. The class will be offered weekly at Preston Hollow United Methodist Church in Dallas, in early 2025.


